

Suzuki LT-R450 Tether Switch Installation

On the right side behind the countershaft sprocket cover there are two sets of wires coming from the cases. Located these wires and follow them upward, they will begin to run toward the back of the quad and eventually go into a black connector. One pair has a blue and a white wire; this is the pair you will use to install the tether.

Using a small saddle type wire connector, take the long wire from the Tether Switch and connect/splice it to the white wire before the connector. Depending on where you mount your tether you may need to add some wire. This is necessary so that the handlebars can have their full range of motion. Turn the bars from side to side to make sure nothing is binding.

Ground the shorter wire from the tether to the frame. You can use any bolt that comes in contact with the frame.

Your tether is now wired properly, verify everything is working correctly and you're ready to ride.
